## TOMAR AND LUSITANO HORSES (UNESCO)

#### Monday, 29 July • 08:30hrs-16:30hrs (Estoril)

A scenic drive inland and north from the coast brings you to Tomar, in the heart of the country. Join your guide for a walk around the heart of Old Town. Cobblestone streets lead past whitewashed houses to Praça da República, lined by a cluster of 17th-century buildings.

Our primary focus here in Tomar is the Convent of Christ, designated a World Heritage Site in 1983. Originally built by the Knights Templar in the 12th century, along with a large fortress used as their headquarters during their battles against the Moors, the convent is considered one of the most important edifices in Europe. The church's structure evolved from its earliest "rotondas" style to include Gothic cloisters, a distinctly Manueline, two-story choir and still more cloisters featuring Corinthian and Tuscan columns, a process which continued off and on for five centuries.

After a thorough overview of the convent, enjoy some free time before continuing today's program. After your lunch break, turn back south towards Vila Franca de Xira for a visit to the Companhia das Lezírias Equestrian Centre. Situated between the Tagus and Sorraia rivers, the ranch is a breeding and training facility for Lusitano horses. Closely related to the more familiar Andalusian breed, the highly-prized Lusitanos are also used in prestigious international competitions. Arrangements have been made for those who would like to do some riding during our stay at the ranch. A tour of the facility, short riding demonstration and wine tasting are also planned.






## BOOK DISCUSSION The Prisoner of Heaven By Carlos Ruiz Zafón
